



The 2019 Macomb Heritage Days Celebration takes place June 27-30th, with the parade beginning promptly at 10:00 am on Saturday, June 29th. The Bob Anstine Memorial Parade will feature the annual Heritage Days Float Contest. Prizes of \$300.00 for first place, \$200.00 for second place, \$100.00 for third place, and the Mayor's Choice will be awarded to the floats which best embody this year's theme.

This year's Heritage Days theme is "Aviation in McDonough County." The committee invites all local businesses, non-profit organizations, service clubs and community members to build their own floats and enter the float competition. Political organizations are also welcome to participate but are not eligible for prizes.

This year an entry fee of \$5 will be charged for all individuals and organizations entering the parade, a fee of \$10 will be charged to all businesses to be paid with your entry form. Parade entries are due by Friday, June 14th. A late fee of \$5 will be charged to everyone entering after the June 14th entry deadline.

For the safety of all spectators and each parade participant, any entry with horses must be accompanied by an adult. **NO CANDY CAN BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES OR FLOATS INTO THE CROWD. Each parade participant must have walkers to distribute candy to the spectators.** Groups seen throwing candy from vehicles will not be allowed to participate in the future. In order to create a more positive experience for parade onlookers, water activities will be limited to the designated water zones only. This will ensure that participants who are not interested in being wet will be safe from inclusion. The Heritage Days Committee also reserves the right to disqualify any entrants deemed inappropriate or offensive. Any offenders will be excluded from future participation.
