For the safety of all spectators and each parade participant, any entry with horses must be accompanied by an adult. NO CANDY CAN BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES OR FLOATS INTO THE CROWD. Each parade participant must have walkers to distribute candy to the spectators. Groups seen throwing candy from vehicles will not be allowed to participate in the future. In order to create a more positive experience for parade onlookers, water activities will be limited to the designated water zones only. This will ensure that participants who are not interested in being wet will be safe from inclusion. The Heritage Days Committee also reserves the right to disqualify any entrants deemed inappropriate or offensive. Any offenders will be excluded from future participation.
